YEAR 6 - KOOTH

This week our Year 6 pupils joined a virtual online session with a mental health support website called Kooth.

Kooth is a fully accredited counselling service with the British Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP), endorsed and supported by the NHS.

Kooth is a free, safe and anonymous online wellbeing service for children and young people. It can be accessed via <https://www.kooth.com/>

Young people using the site are able to access a range of support services including one-to-one counselling sessions, discussing issues with their peers through online discussion boards, reading and contributing to self-help content and recording their feelings via journals and goal trackers.

The online nature of Kooth means that young people can access help in a way that is most suitable for them, at a time that is convenient for them, 365 days of the year.



CEDAR CLASS SCIENCE

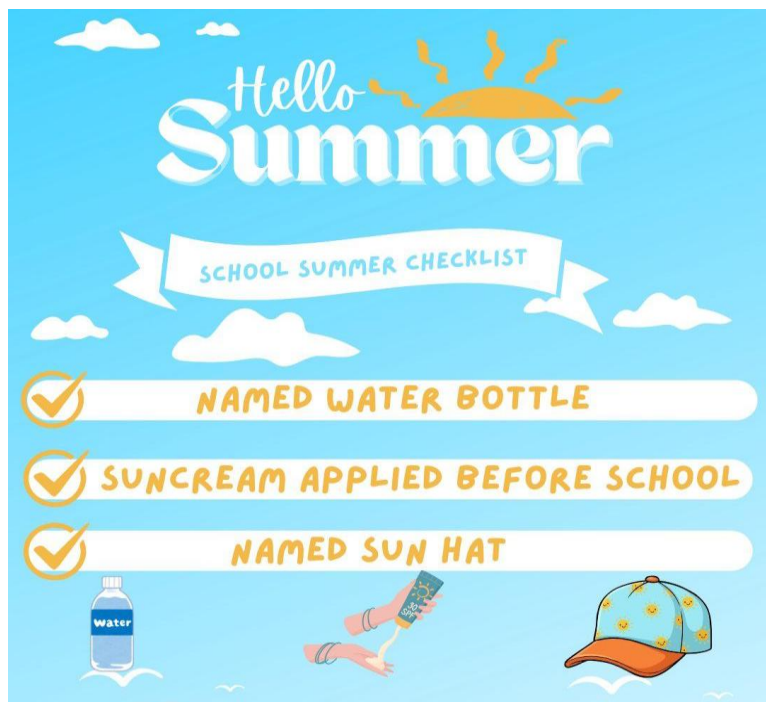

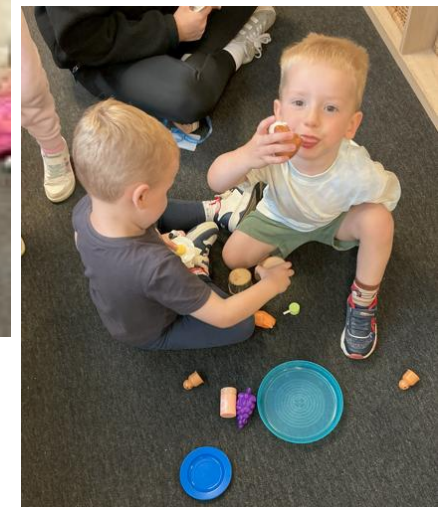
LITTLE LEARNERS
